The Town of Stavelly is selling a **yellow 1988 Chevrolet C6500 Fire Truck** through an **online auction**.


Bidding Information:



STAVELY FIRE DEPARTMENT

Fire Prevention Reminders

As we move into fall, here are a few important fire safety tips:

Smoke Alarms: Install on every level of your home, test monthly, and replace batteries as needed.

Escape Plan: Practice a family escape plan with two exits per room and a safe meeting spot outside.

If Fire Occurs: Get out, stay out, and call 911.

Kitchen Safety: Never leave cooking unattended. For grease fires, cover with a lid and turn off the burner—never use water. Keep flammable items away from the stove.

Outdoor Safety: Use grills and fire pits outdoors, at least 3 feet from buildings, and never leave them unattended. Cool coals completely before disposal in a metal can.
