JOINING EPR PROGRAM

The Town of Stavelly is pleased to announce that we are participating in Alberta's Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) program in partnership with the Alberta Recycling Management Authority (ARMA) and Circular Materials.

As part of this program, blue recycling bins will be delivered to residents in October. This initiative is designed to enhance our community's recycling services and improve waste diversion efforts across town.

The Town will continue to keep residents informed as additional details become available, including collection start dates, the contracted service provider, and the scheduled frequency of pick-up.
