WEATHER ALERT

As of November 26th, 2025 the Weather Alert Colors change to the following:

Alert Colours

! Yellow alerts

- Hazardous weather may cause damage, disruption, or health impacts.
- Impacts are moderate, localized and/or short-term.
- Yellow alerts are the most common.

! Orange alerts

- Severe weather is likely to cause significant damage, disruption, or health impacts.
- Impacts are major, widespread and/or may last a few days.
- Orange alerts are uncommon.

! Red alerts

- Very dangerous and possibly life-threatening weather will cause extreme damage and disruption.
- Impacts are extensive, widespread, and prolonged.
- Red alerts are rare.
