



BYLAW #901 MASTER RATES & FEES

Being a Bylaw of the Town of Staveland, in the Province of Alberta to establish rates, fees and charges for various goods, licenses, permits and services.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the *Municipal Government Act*, RSA 2000, Chapter M-26, as amended, a Municipal Council has the authority to pass Bylaws respecting the Municipality, including services provided by or on behalf of the Municipality; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the *Municipal Government Act*, RSA 2000, Chapter M-26, as amended, a Municipal Council has the authority to govern and to pass Bylaws respecting the Municipality, including establishing fees for licenses, permits and approvals that are higher for persons or businesses who do not reside or maintain a place of business in the Municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Council has deemed it appropriate to establish rates, fees and charges for the various licenses, permits, goods and services provided by the Town of Staveland;

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Town of Staveland, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. Title

1.1 This Bylaw shall be cited as the **Master Rates & Fees Bylaw**.

2. Definitions

2.1 In this Bylaw:

a) **"Residential"** means a property or portion of a property used or intended to be used for human habitation, including single detached dwellings, semi-detached dwellings, duplexes, and individual dwelling units within a Multi-Unit Residential property.

b) **"Non-Residential"** means any property or portion of a property that is not Residential, including but not limited to commercial, industrial, institutional, agricultural, and mixed-use properties where the primary use is not residential habitation.

c) **"School"** means a property used primarily for educational purposes and operated by a recognized school authority, including public schools, separate schools, and any associated buildings or facilities used in support of educational programming.

d) **"Municipal Facility – Community Use"** means a municipally owned building or facility operated, managed, or regularly used by a non-profit organization, volunteer group, or community association for public or community purposes.

d) **"Multi-Unit Residential"** means a property containing two (2) or more self-contained dwelling units located on a single parcel or operated under a unified ownership, management, or condominium structure, including but not limited to apartment buildings, seniors' housing, townhouse developments, and cottage or clustered housing developments.

3. Rates and Fees

3.1 The rates, fees and charges for various goods, licenses, permits and services shall be established as set out in **Schedule "A"**, attached to and forming part of this Bylaw.

3.2 The Town may impose waste collection and disposal fees on any property or facility receiving municipal waste services, including municipally owned facilities operated by third-party organizations, non-profit groups, or volunteer organizations.

3.3 Multi-Unit Residential Properties shall be billed as follows:

- a) A base utility charge shall apply per property; and
- b) A per dwelling unit charge shall apply for each self-contained unit within the property;



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4. Effective Date & Repeal

4.1 This Bylaw shall take effect upon third and final reading.

4.2 Bylaw #891 is now repealed.

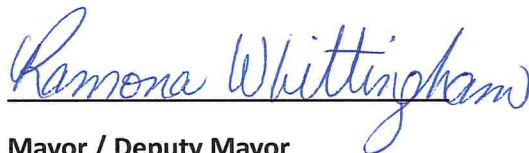

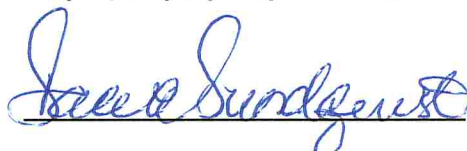
