The Town of Stavelly has watering restrictions & a watering schedule for outside water use to allow time for the pumps to rest.

NO WATERING ON:

Mondays, Thursdays & Fridays

Residents on **South and West** side of the street watering days are **Tuesday & Saturday**

Residents on **North & East** side of the street watering days are **Wednesday & Sunday**

(On watering days no watering between noon—5pm)
