# Foreman Watson – Update on projects / equipment / operations:

- The new fill station is about ready to go. Just completing work on the last components to allow users to fill. We may hold off using the new site until after June 4<sup>th</sup>, as there are water upgrades going on that week, and we won't want the fill station operating.
- SCADA upgrades at the water plant are now scheduled for the first week of June. It will be two or three days of work for the engineering company, and an electrical contractor.
- We have approved two contractors to work on pavement crack filling. The reason for this is to compare how their processes work on our streets.
- The town mowing position has started. This position is also being connected to the community mowing work that has been approved. What it means is that the same person will work in both areas.

### **Upcoming:**

- The entrance to Harvest Hills continues to have water problems on the street. That means water from rainstorms is very slow to move to the proper water course. So, a puddle forms in the street corner. Currently no water is going onto private property. Public works will work with contractors to come up with solution options, and cost variables to solve the issues.
- Hydrant repair company will be in town this week to work on 4 hydrants that are not draining properly. These hydrants have always been operational, but a problem for public works in the wintertime, if they don't drain down.
