REMINDER TO ALL RESIDENTS

The Town of Stavely's main sewer lines were flushed on the week of June 16-20. Our contractor observed some remanence of blockage in the main sewer line.

TIPS FOR HOMEOWNERS

- Be mindful of what is going down your sewer lines—wipes, excessive paper, toys, food from garburators
- Inspect water lines—catch an issue (such as a drip from your piping) prior to it being an emergency
- Ensure your sump-pump is draining to the curb—if it's not making it to the curb water may be entering your basement

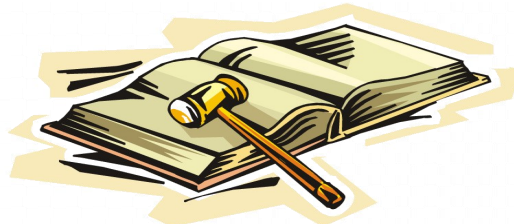
If you notice sewer backup or any plumbing issues in your home please call your local plumber to address the situation.

NEW BYLAW #888

On June 9th, 2025, Town of Stavely Council passed a new bylaw outlining expectations of trees, shrubs and weeds encroaching on Town Property.

This Bylaw ensures that the Town can maintain safe access while conducting their jobs collecting garbage or removing snow from sidewalks.

STAVELY FIRE DEPARTMENT

July is a peak month for grill fires, making fire safety crucial, especially during outdoor cooking. Key tips include keeping grills away from structures, never leaving them unattended, and ensuring good ventilation. Be mindful of other summer hazards like campfires and flammable materials.

GRILLS: Always use grills outdoors and maintain a safe distance from siding, deck railings, and overhanging branches. For gas grills, inspect the gas line for damage and ensure the lid is open before lighting. Keep children and pets at least three feet away. Never leave a grill unattended.

CAMPFIRES: Build campfires at least 25 feet away from tents, shrubs, and anything flammable. Never leave a campfire unattended and have a water source like a hose or bucket nearby.

FIRE PITS/CHIMNEYS: Use these outdoors only, at least 10 feet away from structures or anything that can burn.

WATERING SCHEDULE

The Town of Stavely has watering restrictions and a watering schedule for outside water use to allow time for the pumps to rest.

This restriction is ALWAYS in effect

NO WATERING ON:

Mondays, Thursdays & Fridays

Residents on the **South & West** side of the street may water on **Tuesdays & Saturdays**.

Residents on the **North & East** side of the street may water on **Wednesdays & Sundays**.

Please NO WATERING between noon—5pm
