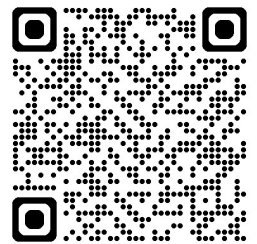

The Town of Stavely would like to remind all residents that it is **YOUR RESPONSIBILITY** to control overgrown vegetation including lawns, trees, and hedges.

These are all **FINABLE OFFENCES** within the Town Owned Property Landscape Management.

If you have any questions or concerns please call the Town Office at 403-549-3761

Obstruction of street lighting; or
Obstruction of traffic control devices; or
Dead or partially dead trees; or
Trees providing less than 4.57 meters (15 feet) vertical clearance over streets; or
Trees providing less than 2.44 meters (8 feet) vertical clearance over sidewalks; or
Trees providing less than 30.5 cm (1 foot) horizontal clearance from sidewalks/curbs; or
Vandalized trees; or
Trees deemed hazardous.
