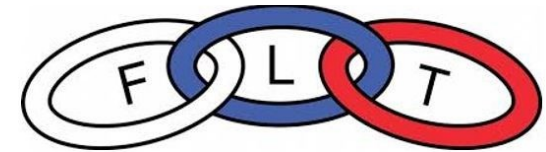

Stavelly Odd Fellows

The Town of Stavelly and the Stavelly Odd Fellows want to support you during this difficult time. Please refer to the Stavelly website for additional information and a contact form.



The Stavelly Odd Fellows, Beaver Lodge #27 owns and maintains the West Cemetery and maintains the Catholic Cemetery located north of Stavelly.

PAYMENTS

Purchase of plots and excavation are separate fees. The Stavelly Odd Fellows takes payment for plots and the Town of Stavelly takes payments for opening & closing. Cheques for plots can be dropped off at the Stavelly Town Office.

HEADSTONES

Headstones can be either flat-mount or upright.



Flat-mount:

The top surface of the headstone must be level with the ground so that a mower can pass over the headstone without contact with the blades of the mower.



Upright:

The headstone must have a concrete or granite foundation placed under it that extends beyond the outermost portion of the headstone by a minimum of 150mm on all sides. The top of the foundation must be level with the ground so that a mower can pass over the foundation without contact with the blades of the mower. The foundation must be a minimum of 50mm thick.

COFFINS

All coffins must be placed inside a concrete vault with a concrete lid. No bodies may be buried without a coffin and a concrete vault. No Green Burials. Coffins cannot be buried in a plot if a cremains urn is already buried in that plot. Coffins must be buried so the top of the concrete vault is at least 1 meter below the ground level.

CREMAIN URNS

The maximum number of cremains urns per full plot is 4 (four). A full plot is considered 1.2m x 2.4m or 3.9ft x 7.9ft. Cremains urns must be buried so the top of the urn is at least 600 mm below the ground level. Cremains urns can be buried above an existing coffin in the same plot.

GIS SERVICES

The Town of Stavelly has Graphic Information Services available on the website under the Cemetery tab. The GIS map allows individuals to view the cemetery and where loved ones are buried or where lots are reserved. A search tab is available at the top on the screen to help find specific people. MAINTENANCE

The Stavelly Odd Fellows mow the lawn, trim hedges, water and control gophers. Although the Stavelly Odd Fellows straighten and relevel the headstones they are property of the purchaser and therefore the purchaser, family and/or friends are encouraged to maintain the headstones.
